***THREE STRIKE RULE  
AGREEMENT***

In order to maintain acceptable attendance in the Youth Enhancement Academy Program, the 100 Black Men of Triangle East Chapter, have composed a ***Three Strike Rule***. This rule will hold each participant accountable for their attendance.

If a participant has a valid reason for not attending the Saturday workshops or other activities hosted by the chapter, they must advise the Mentoring Chair or his representative prior to such activity. They may call and leave a message on the answering machine in order that our records will indicate an excused absence.

Unexcused absences will be recorded, and three such absences will mean that the student can no longer participate in the program. We hope that all parents will understand the importance of regular attendance and realize why this rule was initiated.

Tardiness is another major concern. In order to get the full educational value of the program, everyone must be on time. In the interest of developing punctuality, anyone arriving twenty (20) minutes after the Saturday program has begun will be considered absent.
